


Joining the GHS Listserv

The GHS runs a listserv to foster communication between graduate students in the Department of History. From time to time, members will post items they consider relevant to a large portion of the graduate community. These may include announcements of upcoming talks and seminars, reports from departmental committees, information about jobs and issues arising from the Graduate Students' Union and CUPE 3902, among other things. Notification of GHS meetings and subsequent minutes are also circulated on the listserv. Membership is monitored by the listserv administrator, and no faculty membership is permitted.

To join the GHS listserv, send the following command to **LISTSERV@LISTSERV.UTORONTO.CA**:

subscribe GHS-L Firstname Lastname
